



## Power Requirements for FPED VIII

One standard power hook-up (120 volt, 15 Amp) is free for vendors attending FPED VIII. Each vendor will be supplied with one electrical hook-up or drop per booth space regardless of booth size. Accordingly, power strips are recommended in order to distribute power within that particular booth space.

In the event additional standard drops are required beyond the one that is provided at no charge, or if your particular booth display requires other than standard power, (i.e., 20, 30, 40, 50 Amps, 208 volts, 220 volts, 3 phase, etc.) it will be a vendor responsibility to pay for the cost of hook-up and the cost of the power. Coordination for additional power drops will be made and paid for on site. Since the event services support contractor must apply and pay for a permit from Stafford County to operate his generators, vendors **WILL NOT** be authorized to bring their own personal generators to provide power to their booth spaces or their equipment.
